DAY TRIP TO BARE ISLAND,

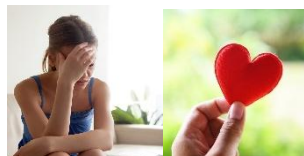
LA PEROUSE AND THE SOUTHERN BEACHES

MAY WALK

Fred Caterson Reserve

Come along for a walk through the bushland in the heart of Castle Hill. The walk commences from Fred Caterson Reserve Field No 1, we will meander through the bushland along the fire trails and walking paths. Keep an eye out for the local birdlife, with Cockatoos, lorikeets, Tawny Frogmouths and Powerful Owls sighted in the reserve. Echidnas have also been spotted in the mornings.

Duration/Length: About 3 hours return. Approx 6km.

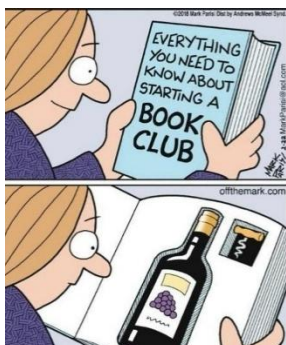
Toilets : James Henty Reserve and coffee break.
